

Lustrum Blacklist Policy – 2020/2021

FAECTOR makes use of a blacklist. A violation of the lustrum blacklist policy gives FAECTOR the right to exclude students on all FAECTOR events in the upcoming three months. One of the following occurrences will count as a violation:

1. Not showing up at a FAECTOR lustrum event after obtaining a ticket, without unsubscribing.
2. Neglecting the corona-rules that are communicated by FAECTOR.

Violations on specific events are:

The Online Lustrum Beer Tasting:

- Not maintaining 1.5m distance during the beer tasting when you are in the zoom call.
- Attending the zoom call with more than two people in the same room.
- Consuming your beer package after unsubscribing for the event.

The Lustrum Rally:

- Not participating in the challenges that are communicated by the Lustrum Committee (the committee has the right to judge whether people have participated in the challenges by taking into account the submissions).
- When people get a violation for this event, people can not get a refund on food and fuel expenses.

Being placed on the lustrum blacklist has no consequences for all other non-lustrum FAECTOR events.
